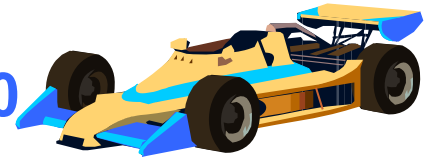




Pack 77 Pinewood Derby 2020



Race Day Info

- Race Day: Saturday, February 1st at the Cale cafeteria
- Registration 11:00am – 1:00pm
- No cars accepted after 2:00pm
- Race starts promptly at 3:00pm, should end by 5:30pm

Race Categories

- Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears – race within each rank only
- Webelos – Note: all Webelos must make their own cars without Adult assistance (only safety supervision)!
- All-comers – Open to scout siblings and parents
- Trophies to top 3 racers in each category plus 3 fan favorites!

Workshops

- Mr. Eric will host Pinewood Derby construction workshops for all Dens on January 19th and 26th – see your Den leader.
- Car construction workshop volunteers are needed - woodworking experience a bonus but not required !

Race Day Volunteers Needed !!

- Set-up Crew 9:00-11:00am – The set-up crew helps to set-up tables and chairs, assemble the race track, prepare work areas, and decorate inside/outside.
- Worktable Crew 10:30am – 2:00pm – The worktable crew helps racers make repairs and any final adjustments to their cars to get them ready to race. The crew has access to a scale, tools, weights, glue, graphite, and other essentials.
- Registration Crew 11:00am – 2:00pm – The registration crew weighs each car, checks the length, width, and height limits using an easy measuring jig, and ensures that each car meets all other race rules and requirements.
- Concessions 3:00-5:30pm – Runs the concession stand with snacks and T-shirts.
- On-Deck Crew Shift 1 3:00-4:15pm – The on-deck crew helps each scout find their car, gets the scouts seated in the correct order in the on-deck area, and helps the scouts place their cars on the racetrack.
- On-Deck Crew Shift 2 4:15-5:30pm – same as above
- Judges 2:00-4:00pm – The judges fill out ribbons given to each entrant. This position requires some creativity (“best blue car,” “best Star Wars car,” etc.).
